

UNM Re-Evaluations

The Office of Guardianship contracts with the UNM Health Sciences Center, Center for Neuropsychological Services for re-evaluations of protected persons under state contracted guardianship. The key purpose of these re-evaluations is to provide information regarding the continuing level of guardianship needed.

These comprehensive evaluations are intended for clients in the following circumstances:

- (1) no comprehensive evaluation has occurred in the last five years;
- (2) comprehensive evaluations may occur sooner than every five years upon mutual agreement between the NMDDPC office of guardianship and a contracted guardianship provider;
- (3) life circumstances resulting in change in condition.

Nearly one in five protected persons re-evaluated (19%) are recommended for a change in level of guardianship, or other action. The chart below illustrates the results of these re-evaluations. The contact at UNM for these re-evaluations for the Office of Guardianship is:
