


COVID-19 Relief & Support Grant Funding for Tribes

FEDERAL GRANT PROGRAMS

Coronavirus Relief Fund

The Treasury will make payments from the Fund to Tribal governments, States and Local governments. Necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency, expenses that were not accounted for in the budget most recently approved as of March 27, 2020, and were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020 and ends on December 20, 2020.

Application Deadline: April 17, 2020, by 11:59 pm (EDT)

- Geographic coverage: Nationwide
- Recipients need to submit application documents to Department of Treasury portal.
- Sponsors: Department of Treasury, Department of Interior
- Estimated Award Date: Awards must be distributed no later than April 24, 2020.

Supporting Tribal Public Health Capacity in Coronavirus Preparedness and Response

Non-competitive grants for Tribal governments and Tribal organizations to carry out public health emergency response activities in response to COVID-19. Activities may include surveillance, epidemiology, laboratory capacity, infection control, mitigation, communications, and other preparedness and response activities.

Application Deadline: May 31, 2020, by 11:59 pm (EDT)

- Geographic coverage: Nationwide
- Recipients will have up to 60 days to respond and submit applications. Applications will be reviewed immediately, and awards will be made on a rolling basis.
- Sponsors: Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services
- Estimated Award Date: 10 calendar days upon receipt of application.

National Tribal Broadband Grant

The Office of Indian Energy and Economic Development (IEED), Office of the Assistant Secretary—Indian Affairs, is soliciting proposals from Indian Tribes for grant funding to hire consultants to perform feasibility studies for deployment or expansion of high-speed internet (broadband) transmitted, variously, through digital subscriber line (DSL), cable modem, fiber, wireless, satellite and broadband over power lines (BPL)

Applications will be accepted until 11:59 p.m. EST on Friday, May 8, 2020.
