Annual Report for Foley Lawsuit October 15, 2013

The Foley Lawsuit is regarding former residents of the State's Training Schools who are not members of the Jackson Class. The lawsuit resulted in a settlement and the terms are detailed in a January 8, 2010 Settlement Outline, which was approved by the Federal Court on March 26, 2010. The settlement provides for the compilation of an Annual Report for a period of five years regarding the circumstances of the former residents of the State's Training Schools, as follows:

The DD Planning Council will, within available resources, for a period of five years, annually gather information from all parties, to the extent that it is made available, regarding the circumstances of former residents of the State's Training Schools, who are not members of the Jackson Class, and publish an annual public report which describes the circumstances of those persons.

It is recognized and agreed that the DDPC will do no independent investigation of facts regarding the report in question, but merely compile information from other parties.

The DD Planning Council (DDPC) requested information from all parties. This report includes the following:
