These courses provide the broad basis to understand the fields of guardianship and conservatorship, and their ethical practice.

These courses were developed based on the National Guardianship Association Ethics and Standards, but designed to provide expanded, in-depth local training, with emphasis on ethics and practice per New Mexico law.

The intended audience for this program includes:

- -practicing family and professional guardians and conservators
- -new family and professional guardians and conservators
- -people who are changing careers
- -social workers, nurses, attorneys CPAs, others in related fields; those seeking CEUs, CPEs, CLEs
- -others interested in learning more about the complexities of guardianship and conservatorship.
- -people seeking CEUs for Center for Guardianship Certification (CGC) re-certification.

The courses are being offered on Saturdays to be accessible apart from the work week.

Out-of-town attendees can apply for student housing at UNM for \$26 to \$38 a night.


